Subject: First Quarter 2022 Building Permit Report

Recommendation:

THAT Report BLD-02-2022 re: First Quarter 2022 Building Permit Report be received as information.

Purpose:

To advise Council of the status of building permit activity for Middlesex Centre for the first quarter of 2022.

Background:

Building permit activity for the first quarter of 2022 has continued the momentum of 2021 and exceeded 2021's first quarter statistics by 50%-100%. New residential starts for 2022 total 103 whereas 2021 totalled 50. Also, total permits have increased from 150 to 200 and total construction value has increased from \$34,906,918 to \$65,544,262.

Analysis:

Similar reports will be presented to the councils of Adelaide Metcalfe, Southwest Middlesex, Lucan Biddulph and North Middlesex. These will be provided to Middlesex Centre Council following those presentations. Further Middlesex Centre information is outlined below in Tables 1 and 2.
