



**Municipality of Middlesex Centre
BY-LAW 2023-014**

Being a by-law to delegate certain powers and duties under the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, and other Acts

WHEREAS section 23.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 (the Act) authorizes a municipality to delegate its powers and duties to a person or body, subject to certain restrictions;

AND WHEREAS section 224(d) of the Act states it is the role of Council to ensure that administrative practices and procedures are in place to implement the decisions of Council;

AND WHEREAS section 227 of the Act states it is the role of officers and employees of the municipality to; (a) implement Council's decisions and establish administrative practices and procedures to carry out Council's decisions; and (c) carry out other duties under this or any other Act and other duties assigned by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre has identified certain routine administrative functions to be delegated to staff to improve daily business efficiencies while continuing to adhere to the principles of accountability and transparency;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

The purpose of the Delegated Authority By-Law is to formalize and clarify the delegated authority assigned to staff in regards to certain administrative functions as set out in the Schedules appended hereto.

2. Definitions

- 2.1. "Council", means the Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre;
- 2.2. "Director", means a department head; or that person's designate;
- 2.3. "Person", means an individual, partnership, corporation, association, club, business entity, incorporated group or organization, federal or provincial government, crown agent, school board or regional or local municipality;
- 2.4. "Municipality", means the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre;
- 2.5. "Municipal Lands", means lands owned by or leased or licensed to or under the management of the Municipality, Municipal easements, and shall include but not be limited to any road, lane, public highway, right of way, park, woodland, greenbelt, storm water management facility, open space, municipal cemetery and lands in which the Municipality holds any real property interest, and all parts thereof, including any surface, grassed area, boulevard, ditch, curb, gutter, and sidewalk.

3. Roles & Responsibilities

- 3.1. THAT Council delegates the powers, duties, and restrictions thereto as set out in the Schedules A through D, appended hereto, to those officers and employees listed therein;
- 3.2. THAT any officer acting under delegated authority provided to them within this by-law has the authority to bind the corporation on agreements related to such delegated authority;
- 3.3. THAT the Chief Administrative Officer may act in the absence of any delegate that has been delegated authority under this By-law in time sensitive situations;
- 3.4. THAT Council retains the authority to reconsider and may revoke any delegated power that has been delegated pursuant to this By-law;
- 3.5. Where the exercise of a delegated authority requires an expenditure of money, funding for the expenditure shall be included in an approved budget and all relevant requirements of the purchasing and procurement procedures in effect at the time of the expenditure shall be followed.

4. Appointment of Signing Officers

- 4.1. The Mayor and the Clerk or their designates are hereby appointed signing officers of the Municipality and may jointly execute any document on behalf of the Municipality, unless specifically provided for in the Schedules appended.

5. Severability

- 5.1. In the event that any provision or part of this By-law is found to be invalid for any reason whatsoever, then the particular provision or part thereof shall be deemed to be severed from the remainder of the By-law and all other provisions or parts thereof shall remain in full force and shall be valid;
- 5.2. In the event of any inconsistency between this By-law and any other Municipal by-law the more restrictive provision shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency.

6. Title

This By-law shall be known as the “Delegated Authority By-law”

7. Final Passing

- 7.1. THAT the delegated authority pertaining to Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, found in schedule C of this by-law, does not come into force and take effect until after Amendment No. 61 to the Middlesex Centre Official Plan has been approved by the County of Middlesex in accordance with the provisions of Section 24(2) of the Planning Act, R.S.O 1990;
- 7.2. AND THAT this by-law shall come into force when it is passed and enacted by Council, save and except the delegated authority referred to in section 7.1.
