Subject: Tender Results – Komoka Drainage Works Union Ave Branch

Recommendation:

THAT the construction of the Komoka Drainage Works Union Ave Branch be awarded to the lowest tender bid submission received from J & L Henderson Ltd. in the amount of \$99,880 + HST.

Purpose:

To obtain Council approval of the tender award with regards to proceeding with the drainage works under the Ontario Drainage Act.

Background:

A request for Drainage Improvement was submitted to Middlesex Centre to request an improvement to the Union Ave Branch of the Komoka Drainage Works.

By-Law #2021-076 was passed enacting the Engineer's report prepared by Brad Bunke, GM BluePlan for the drain design and cost estimate. The project proceeded to the public tendering stage with four tenders submitted.

Analysis:

The following tender results were received through a public tendering process and are listed as follows:

J & L Henderson Ltd	\$99,880 + HST
Frank Van Bussel & Sons Ltd	\$134,183 + HST
Ro-Buck Contracting	\$149,415 + HST
Van Bree Drainage & Bulldozing Ltd	\$140,475.70 + HST

Financial Implications:

GM BluePlan staff have reviewed the bid for compliance with the respective tender requirements and the lowest tender bid submission from J & L Henderson Ltd. has been recommended to be awarded.

The cost estimate for construction provided by GM BluePlan was \$50,000.00 + HST for the Municipal Drain Construction. The tendered price of \$99,880.00 includes the cost of construction for the Municipal Drainage work as per the Drainage Report as well as a Municipal project to remove and replace the wooden noise fence adjacent to the Municipal Drain. The tender price of \$99,880.00 consists of \$55,933 that will be assessed to landowners for Municipal Drain construction and \$43,947 for Municipal work.
