Subject: Celebrating Middlesex Centre's 25th Anniversary

#### **Recommendation:**

THAT Report CPS-20-2023 regarding plans for celebrating Middlesex Centre's 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary be received as information.

#### Purpose:

This report provides an initial overview of the activities planned to celebrate the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre.

### Background:

The Municipality of Middlesex Centre was established on January 1, 1998, with the amalgamation of the former Townships of Delaware, Lobo, and London. This year, 2023, marks 25 years since our new municipality was formed. Over that time, we've grown from a municipality of roughly 13,600<sup>1</sup> to one of nearly 20,000 residents.

Now is this the time to celebrate all we've accomplished over the past 25 years, and bring together the residents, businesses, service groups and clubs that continue to make our community vibrant and successful.

### Analysis:

An internal group of staff from all departments came together to develop a program for the year. Rather than one large event, several smaller events and programs are planned throughout the year, targeted at different age groups and interests. To keep costs and additional staffing requirements low, some existing / planned municipal activities will include a 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary element.

Supporting outreach through communication channels (social media, print, etc.) will be associated with events and programs as appropriate.

Some items on the list are already underway, such as the new Middlesex Centre 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Banners on display at the Komoka Wellness Centre and Ilderton Arenas.



# Financial Implications:

Funding for the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary programs and events was included in the 2023 budget under the general government operating budget (\$25,000). Grants and sponsorships will be sought to offset and/or add to the funds available.
