Subject: First Quarter 2023 Building Activity Summary

Recommendation:

THAT Report BLD-02-2023 re: First Quarter 2023 Building Activity Summary be received as information

Purpose:

To advise Council of the status of building permit activity for Middlesex Centre for the first quarter of 2023.

Background:

Building permit activity for the first quarter of 2022 has continued to reflect the significant slowdown started in mid 2022. In the first quarter of 2023, new residential units and construction value reduced to 14 and \$11 million respectively from 103 dwellings and \$65 million construction value in the first quarter of 2022.

Analysis:

Similar reports will be presented to the councils of Adelaide Metcalfe, Southwest Middlesex, Lucan Biddulph and North Middlesex. Construction in these municipalities has also slowed but not to the same level as Middlesex Centre. These reports will be provided to Middlesex Centre Council following those presentations. Further Middlesex Centre information is outlined below in Tables 1 and 2.
