Recommendation:

Purpose:

To obtain Council direction with regard to proceeding with drainage works under Section 4 of the Ontario Drainage Act

Background:

A Petition for Drainage was submitted to Middlesex Centre to request the creation of a new Municipal Drain to handle water the property is experiencing from Amiens Road both from the surface as well as conveyed underneath the road through a culvert. The water currently flows easterly over the property into the low are and onwards to the natural watercourse. The petitioner is looking to control that water and prevent the ponding and damage that their property is currently experiencing.
