



**Municipality of Middlesex Centre
BY-LAW 2023-055**

**Being a by-law of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre to
amend the Parking and Traffic By-law 2018-092**

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 the Council of a local municipality may pass by-laws to amend By-Law 2018-092, being a by-law to revise and consolidate certain by-laws regulating Traffic and the Parking of Motor Vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre enacts as follows:

1. THAT DEFINITIONS , be amended by the addition of the following:

“Bus Bay” means a portion of the highway which is designed and constructed outside of the roadway adjacent to it for the purpose of stopping buses while in the act of picking up or discharging passengers.

“Bus Stop” means that portion of a roadway abutting the curb or portion of shoulder abutting a roadway. Indicated by a posted official sign for the purpose of stopping busses operated by or on behalf of Middlesex County or Middlesex Centre while picking up or discharging passengers.

2. THAT PART 1 – TRAFFIC, be amended by the addition of the following:

28. No Stopping at Bus Stops (Schedule 18)

(1) Where official “Bus Stop” signs are erected and are on display, which signs are hereby authorized, no person other than those persons operating a bus for or on behalf of Middlesex County or Middlesex Centre shall stop a vehicle to load or unload passengers or merchandise on any street.

3. THAT TABLE OF SCHEDULES, be amended by the addition of the following:

4. THAT SCHEDULE 18 – NO STOPPING AT BUS STOPS, be amended by the addition of the following:

5. AMEND/REPEAL OF BY-LAW

This By-law amends the Traffic and Parking By-law 2018-092

6. TITLE

This By-law shall be known as Amendment to the Parking and Traffic By-law – By-law 2023-055

7. FINAL PASSING

THAT this by-law shall come into force when it is passed and enacted by Council.
