BY-LAW 2023-057

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre to amend the Parking and Traffic By-law 2018-092

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 the Council of a local municipality may pass by-laws to amend By-Law 2018-092, being a by-law to revise and consolidate certain by-laws regulating Traffic and the Parking of Motor Vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre enacts as follows:

- 1. That SCHEDULE 5 – ENTERING HIGHWAY (STOP SIGNS ON SPECIFIED STREETS), be amended by the addition of the following:

Table with 3 columns: Column 1 Traffic, Column 2 Street, Column 3 Intersection. Rows include Westbound Bridge Street/Pleasant Street, Westbound Sir James Court/Sir Robert Place, and Eastbound Croydon Place/Croydon Drive.

- 2. AMEND/REPEAL OF BY-LAW:

This By-law amends the Traffic and Parking By-law 2018-092

- 3. TITLE:

This By-law shall be known as Amendment to the Parking and Traffic By-law – By-law 2023-057

- 4. FINAL PASSING:

THAT this by-law shall come into force when it is passed and enacted by Council.
