Subject Old River Road, PIC1 - Comments Summary (Final)

A Public Information Centre was held on March 2, 2023, from 4:00 p.m., to 6:00 p.m., at the Komoka Wellness Centre. Fourteen people signed-in and attended the meeting plus representatives from the Municipality and Arcadis IBI Group.

The purpose of the meeting was to present the preferred Glendon Drive EA alternative for Old River Road and provide the opportunity for the public to ask questions and give input prior to detailed design.

The following is a summary of the comments received to-date (March 29, 2023).

Date Received	Comment
2023-03-03 Email	KMarshall Gate access, strongly suggest that access to Old River Rd from Pulham be available 24/7 at very least to residents of the road.
	Old River Road/Glendon Intersection: dangerous, especially during peak traffic hours. Relocating the intersection further west may not reduce the danger.
	Hill on Old River Road: during snow conditions can be treacherous.
2023-03-04 Email	JLarid Gate access, safety of residents with decreased traffic and flexibility of exits in case of emergency/road conditions etc.
	<u>Gate Access:</u> Allowing access on a "honour" system, self managed by the residents. I am in favour of this "if" all residents agree to comply with keeping the gate locked and access is also provided to our neighbours on Pulham.
	<u>CN Tracks</u> : Access to residents south of Old River Road, who could be trapped in an emergency by the CN tracks.
	<u>Temporary Residents Access:</u> I do have issues with providing key access to any renters (there is only one rental property on the road) as I believe compliance would be an issue.
	<u>Mailboxes:</u> Moving the mailboxes to ensure we have access that is within our new road parameters.
	Other Issue: Not project related, regarding bridge construction on Glendon Drive

Email	Old River Road/Glendon Intersection:
	 High rate of accidents. The hill presents a visual impairment to oncoming traffic for anyone attempting to a lefthand turn onto Glendon Drive. This also me be more problematic one a third lane is placed to allow a left turn on Elmhurst.
	Speed is also a concerning factor.
	 A closure or gate is an excellent solution. This will also prevent the slowing of vehicles to allow for a right hand turn onto River Road during rush hours.
	Preserve as much of the 'greeness' as possible, showcasing its distinctiveness as traffic enters and exists Middlesex Centre.

	Old River Road/Glendon Intersection: 93% of accidents occurred at Glendon/Old River Road; suggesting lights and possibly no left turns between 7-9 a.m. and 4-7 p.m.
	Emergency access at all times.
	<u>Hill on Old River Road</u> : The residents need a choice of entering Old River Road because the hill on Old River Road is steep and poorly supported curve.

The main concern is access during an emergency situation. Residents would like gate access for emergency purposes:

- During an emergency situation when the CN Tracks are blocked and there is no access to Vanneck Road;
- During winter season when the hill on Old River Road poses slippery conditions and is unsafe to drive;
- The Glendon/Old River Road intersection is very dangerous due to the line of sight, plus due to wintery road conditions when travelling downhill and trying to make a left turn onto Old River Road.
