Subject:	Fees and Charges By-Law 2024

Recommendation:

THAT Report CPS-51-2023, re: Fees and Charges By-law 2024 be received;

AND THAT the 2024 Fees and Charges By-law attached as Appendix 'A1' be approved.

Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to provide Council with the recommended municipal fees and charges for 2024 for review and discussion.

Background:

Part XII of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended permits municipalities to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons:

- a) for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;
- b) for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board; and
- c) for the use of its property including property under its control.

In accordance with Middlesex Centre Notice By-law 2010-080, notice of intent to pass the Fees and Charges By-law has been posted on the municipal website at least once during the ten days prior to the intended date of passing. Staff posted notice of the proposed Fees and Charges By-law changes on the municipal website on Oct. 16, 2023. Additionally, staff advertised in the Oct. 25, 2023, edition of the Middlesex Banner and in the Oct. 27, 2023, municipal e-newsletter that the proposed 2024 Fees and Charges By-law would be presented to Council on Nov. 15. 2023.

Analysis:
