Re: Municipal Drinking Water System Infrastructure in Unassumed Subdivisions

The Municipality of Middlesex Centre operates and maintains the Middlesex Centre Water Distribution System under the authority of the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP).

The Municipality of Middlesex Centre must operate the Water System in accordance with all applicable Acts and Regulations, but also according to the conditions detailed in the Middlesex Centre's Drinking Water Works Permit (DWWP) and Municipal Drinking Water Licence (MDWL), which are issued by the MECP.

Condition 2.7 of Schedule B of Middlesex Centre's DWWP states the following:

The owner shall notify the legal owner of any part of the drinking water system that is prescribed as a municipal drinking water system by section 2 of O. Reg. 172/03 of the requirements of the licence and this drinking water works permit as applicable to the prescribed system.

Ontario Regulation 172/03 defines water infrastructure within unassumed municipal subdivisions as being part of the municipal drinking water system. Under this definition, you have been identified as the legal owner of components of Middlesex Centre's municipal drinking water system under the following Registered Plans:
