### Purpose:

To inform Council regarding the tender results of the Komoka Community Centre Roof Replacement project (RFT-CMS-2024-01)

#### Background:

In accordance with the corporate Procurement of Goods & Services Policy, dated January 1, 2021, Tender No. RFT-CMS-2024-01 was publicly tendered utilizing Bids & Tenders, an online portal that connects suppliers providing various goods and services to buyers from the Municipal, Provincial, Education, Crown Corporation, Housing, Construction and Healthcare sectors and Private companies from across Canada.

# **Analysis:**

Following the submission of bids on April 11, 2024, eight (8) submissions were evaluated through the Bids & Tenders portal.
