Gordon noted that staff do not intend to submit any comments in response to the Notice of Proposed Zoning Order for the City of St. Thomas. The MZO is being considered to change existing Open Space, Agricultural, Natural Heritage and Natural Hazard Zones to Employment Lands to facilitate the development of the Yarmouth Yards Industrial Park. There is nothing in the MZO that directly affects KCCA's jurisdiction. Only a 1/3 of the development lands are within the Kettle Creek watershed. In regard to CA mandated programs and services, the MZO permits the City to make drainage changes and remove water features and hazard designations from the site. However, the affected water features and natural hazard designations are all within the Catfish Creek watershed. There is only one minor watercourse within the KCCA watershed on the property that is being maintained for the stormwater outlet and despite the MZO powers, the City, through its Preliminary Services Report intends to maintain the existing watershed boundaries. KCCA's regulatory jurisdiction affecting the subject lands is minimal and has been reduced with recent changes to the CA Act and O. Reg.41/24. The MZO appears to focus on Natural Heritage, Archeology, Servicing and Transportation justification to support the zoning change.

A full replacement is costly however, temporary repairs/modifications can be immediately undertaken for under \$5,000. This work will ensure the washroom can continue to function until a full or partial replacement can be planned and budgeted.
