### **Recommendation:**

THAT Report CPS-09-2025 regarding Procurement Activity in 2024 be received for information.

#### Purpose:

To present to Council the results of the municipality's procurement activity in 2024.

### Background:

Under the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, municipalities must adopt policies with respect to their procurement of goods and services. Middlesex Centre does this through its Procurement Policy. This policy outlines the process the municipality follows when procuring goods and services to ensure fairness, objectivity and transparency, and that the municipality is obtaining the best value for money, among other objectives.

While the policy outlines processes for procurements at all dollar values, this report focusses on procurements for goods and services conducted through request for proposal / tendering via the bids&tenders eProcurement platform. It also summarizes purchases through the LAS buying group.

### Analysis:

Middlesex Centre undertook 25 procurement processes through bids&tenders in 2024. The total value of those procurement processes was \$9,635,048. The following table presents an overview of these procurement processes.

## **Financial Implications:**

Managing procurement processes is undertaken by staff at the municipality, the cost of which is included in the annual operating budget. The costs of goods and services purchased is also included in the annual budget (operating and/or capital). Goods and services that fall outside of the approved budget amounts and/or that do not meet stated procurement requirements in the policy (for example, requiring three bids), are brought to Council for approval, as outlined in the Procurement Policy.
