

Petition for Drainage Works by Road Authority – Form 2

Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. D.17, subs. 4(1)(c)

To: The Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre

The Ballymote East Municipal Drain services the lands at the southeast corner of Highbury Ave and Medway Road.

It has been discovered that a connection from the west side of Highbury has been added since the original drain construction. The petition is looking to extend the Ballymote East Municipal Drain to the west side of Highbury ave to provide a legal outlet for the lands and the west side of Highbury Ave. The existing Municipal Drain will also need to be improved to increase capacity to account for the additional lands as well as to reflect current storm events.

- Once the petition is accepted by council, an engineer is appointed to respond to the petition. *Drainage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. D. 17 subs. 8(1).
- After the meeting to consider the preliminary report, if the petition does not comply with section 4, the project is terminated and the road authority is responsible for the costs. *Drainage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. D. 17 subs. 10(4).
- After the meeting to consider the final report, if the petition does not comply with section 4, the project is terminated and the road authority is responsible for the costs. *Drainage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. D. 17 s. 43.
- If the project proceeds to completion, a share of the cost of the project will be assessed to the involved properties in relation to the assessment schedule in the engineer's report, as amended on appeal. *Drainage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. D. 17 s. 61.
