Each year, it is estimated that more than 40,000 pets die in fires, most succumbing to smoke inhalation. The reality in most cases is that first responders lack the equipment to resuscitate and save these animals. Each kit includes a small, medium, and large mask. These masks are designed to provide a comfortable and secure fit for pets, helping firefighters provide life-saving oxygen support for our beloved pets”.
