

## Municipality of Middlesex Centre BY-LAW 2025-059

Being a bylaw to amend the appointment of members of Council and members of the public to the committees of Council and local boards of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre

**WHEREAS** the Council for the Municipality of Middlesex Centre deems it desirable and expedient to appoint members of Council and of the public to the committees and boards of the Municipality and to such other committees and boards required for the affairs and representation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council for the Municipality of Middlesex Centre has previously adopted by-law 2022-109 to appoint members of Council and members of the public to the committees of Council and local boards of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council for the Municipality of Middlesex Centre deems it expedient to amend by-law 2022-109;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre enacts as follows:

1. That the "Public Representation" portion of Section 2.1 (Community Services Advisory Committee) of By-law 2022-109, enacted and passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre on the 7th day of December 2022, be deleted, and the following substituted therefore:

Public Representation: Heather Greig, Shereen Miller, Margaret Gelinas, Vanessa Cullen, Danny Jeffries, Adam Petrenko, Dave Johnson, and Christina Sachanowicz

2. AND THAT Section 2.2 (Youth Advisory Committee) of By-law 2022-109, enacted and passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre on the 7th day of December 2022, be removed.
