### Purpose:

To advise Council of the status of by-law enforcement matters for the year 2020.

### Background:

#### New By-laws

The following By-laws have been brought to council for approval in 2020:

- Municipal Right of Way By-law regulating to the use, protection and regulation of the municipal right of ways in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre (Passed)
- Mobile Food Outlet By-law regulating and govern Mobile Food Outlets and Produce Stands within the Municipality (Not passed) Note: staff will bring the updated by-law in 2021

## Proactive By-law Enforcement Patrols

- In early March, the Commissionaires parking and parks enforcement came to an end due to staffing issues. These responsibilities were added to our full-time enforcement officer daily tasks.
- Conducted multiple overnight parking shifts to issue parking warnings, issue tickets and address obstructions on the municipal property to prepare for plowing operations.

• Extensive proactive patrols in municipal parks to enforce and monitor new covid-19 restrictions and ensure compliance with Animal Control on/off leash requirements.
