## **Recommendation:**

That staff report BD-02-2021 be received.

### Purpose:

To provide council with an update of building department activity for the first half of 2021.

### Information:

Earlier this year, Middlesex Centre's Building Division entered into service agreements with the Townships of North Middlesex, Adelaide Metcalfe and Southwest Middlesex. Building Division has also increased the number of inspectors this year by 3 to maintain service levels and to provide this service to the three new municipalities. We are satisfied that our service to Lucan Biddulph has been maintained, which is largely due to the use of Cloudpermit (on-line permitting) by all five municipalities.

Construction activity in Lucan Biddulph for the first half of 2021 is generally consistent with previous years' totals, in that residential development is very healthy and in demand. Unfortunately, comparative information for the first half of 2020 is not available. It is anticipated that we'll see another very strong year of growth in Lucan Biddulph. The following tables are provided to inform council of Building Department activities for the first half of this year and comparative totals from previous years.

Fees paid to Middlesex Centre for inspection and by-law enforcement services over the first half total approximately \$39,000.
