



Municipality of Middlesex Centre
By-Law 2021-081

Being a by-law to dedicate 0.3m (1 foot) Reserve Blocks for public purposes (Blocks 71 and 75 on Plan 33M-738)

WHEREAS Section 5 (3) of The Municipal Act, Chapter, S.O. 2001, c. M.25 as amended, states that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 27(1) of the Municipal Act, a municipality may pass by-laws in respect of a highway;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 31(2) of the Municipal Act provides that land may only become a public highway pursuant to a by-law establishing the public highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre deems it expedient to assume and dedicate certain portions of road for public purposes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Municipality of Middlesex Centre enacts as follows:

- 1) THAT Blocks 71 and 75 on Plan 33M-738 in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre (as shown on Schedule "A" attached) and the same are hereby assumed and dedicated 0.3m (1 foot) reserves for public road purposes.
